The AEF's Public Education and Special Projects Committee leads the AEF's efforts in outreach to the general public and educational institutions throughout the state. The Committee directs the AEF's programs, such as the Student Convention Program, the Randall Mathis and Larry Wilson Scholarships for Environmental/Engineering Studies, sponsorship of Regional Science Fairs and the Arkansas Academy of Science Awards, and the AEF Diamond Award for Excellence in Environmental Leadership. The Committee is responsible for fundraising to support these initiatives, including the AEF's annual golf tournament in conjunction with the Convention & Trade Show. The Committee also has oversight responsibilities for the AEF's public website. The Committee meets at the call of the Chair and is open to all AEF members in good standing.
