The AEF's Government Affairs Committee advises the Board and staff on issues related to coordinating the AEF's activities as they interface with local, state, regional and federal agencies and governing bodies. The Committee considers the impact of AEF initiatives on relationships with those groups, conducts public relations with government agencies and the state legislature, develops the AEF's legislative agenda and reviews proposed legislation. The Committee works to inform the AEF membership, similar associations, administrative officials and state legislators of the potential impact of legislation on Arkansas's industries. The Committee oversees the weekly distribution of the AEF's Legislative Bulletin during legislative sessions. The Committee meets at the call of the Chair and is open to AEF members in good standing. Member companies may have more than one representative on the Membership Committee.
