

FAQs for the NASL 30th Annual Meeting



Hotel Reservations/Housing: Convention Management Resources, Inc. (CMR) is the official housing company for the NASL room block at the **Hyatt Regency Orlando**. Contact them at **866-227-1876** for reservations Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. - 9 p.m. (Eastern). **NASL has a separate room block, so be sure to identify yourself as an NASL registrant to be placed in the correct block and receive the special \$284 per night conference rate.** NASL attendees are not required to supply a confirmation number to make a reservation.

NASL Registration: NASL registration opens for check-in and on-site registration Sunday morning, October 13, at 7:00am. Beat the lines and stop by during the morning hours to pick up your name badge.

NASL Sessions: NASL general sessions and Committee meetings are all being held in the **Hyatt Regency Orlando** and begin on **Sunday, October 13 at 12pm** with our **Welcome to Orlando Social**. The Social will offer your first networking opportunity of the NASL Annual Meeting and feature a light lunch. Sessions begin immediately thereafter, promptly at 1pm.

NASL/AHCA Rehabilitation Symposium: The 6th Annual NASL/AHCA Rehabilitation Symposium precedes the NASL Annual Meeting, beginning at 8am on Sunday, October 13, in the Orange County Convention Center. Registrants for the 6th Annual NASL/AHCA Rehabilitation Symposium are required to check in and pick up a badge at AHCA registration in the Orange County Convention Center before entry into the session which begins on Sunday at 8am sharp.

Expo Hall: For your convenience, tickets to the AHCA Expo Hall on Monday and Tuesday may be purchased during your online registration process at www.NASL.org. The fee is \$55 per day, so please indicate which day you plan to attend. Your NASL name badge will be color-coded to indicate the day for which you purchased entry. You must display your NASL name badge to gain entry to the Expo Hall.

Crossover to AHCA Convention Sessions: NASL registrants enjoy complimentary access to several AHCA/NCAL Convention activities. These include non-ticketed professional development sessions and opening and closing sessions. NASL registrants do not, however, have access to the AHCA/NCAL Convention app, nor do they receive continuing education credit. NASL registrants who sign-up for the co-hosted Rehabilitation Symposium, however, will receive instructions to access materials on the AHCA/NCAL Convention app, and will receive continuing education credits for attendance at this session.

What to Wear: The weather in Orlando is expected to be in the mid-80s during the day and in the low-60s in evenings. Temperatures in meeting rooms are unpredictable, so please dress in layers to assure your comfort.

The Hyatt Regency Orlando is within walking distance to the Orange County Convention Center. Wear comfortable shoes and enjoy a bit of exercise when moving between venues.
