

Fellow Award

Description of the Award: Advancement to Fellow status is granted to individuals who are currently active members of the American School Health Association (ASHA) and who have been an active member of ASHA for at least 10 consecutive years. It is based on evidence of leadership and service to ASHA. Documentation for the Fellow award will be reviewed by the members of ASHA's Award Committee and approved by the ASHA Board of Directors. Awards will be announced during the Awards ceremony at the annual conference.

Criteria:

- Have current ASHA membership and been a member for 10 or more consecutive years.
- Have shown evidence of substantive and consistent leadership and service on ASHA committees, councils, sections, or boards.
- Have been nominated by a fellow of the association.

Nominee Packet should include:

- A cover letter from the nominating ASHA Fellow describing the individual's leadership and service to ASHA.
- Documentation formatted using the categories below mirroring the evaluation rubric. (Bullets under the headings are possible examples of contributions in each category and are provided to support the nominee/nominator in completing the nominee packet.)
- Documentation for this award should be submitted to Abby Brdlik at abrdlik@ashaweb.org by the close of business on **Friday, April 4, 2014**.

- Chair of BOD Subcommittee, Task Force, Ad Hoc Committee or Standing Committee

- Chair of a Task Force, Standing Committee or Subcommittee of a Council/Section
- Other ASHA leadership: leader/chair of professional development activities, conference planning committee or other ASHA events
- FLA member

- ASHA Committee/Task Force membership
- ASHA Council/Section committee membership
- ASHA service as a liaison representative
- ASHA service on professional development activities, reviewer of conference programs, etc.

ASHA PRESENTATIONS, PUBLICATIONS, ETC.

- ASHA Presentations and/or publications, Oral presentations, Pre/post workshops, Poster session or round table presentations at ASHA National Conference or events.
- Reviewer of *Journal of School Health* articles, published in the *Journal of School Health*
- Other ASHA professional activities: reviewing CEU's, non-compensated writing projects for ASHA, grant writing on behalf of ASHA, etc.
