MN Triad Secretary Pauline Fahey called the meeting to order. There were 15 in attendance from 5 Triad counties.

Treasurer's Report: M/S/P (Lisa Lovering/Julie Wyffels) to approve the Treasurer's Report, after review and date correction by Treasurer Evan Verbrugge.

Information Sharing: We talked about the possibility of putting together another MN Triad cookbook and asking people to bring recipes to the conference. If you are interested in working on this project, please let one of the officers know.

There continues to be a lot of interest on Facebook and Pauline does a lot of sharing. MN Sheriffs' Association is also sharing a lot from Sheriff's Offices throughout the state. After discussion, it was decided that we would make the newsletter shorter (one page, front/back), include a "Did You Know," and ask Triad groups to designate one of their members to share information on what is happening in their counties so that it can be included in the newsletter, on Facebook and/or on the MSA MN Triad Website. This would include events you host or participate in, projects, programs, upcoming events.

MN TRIAD Conference Updates: Lisa from Isanti gave an update on this year's conference. It will be September 23-25 at the St Cloud Kelly Inn. Don Shelby is the keynote speaker. Lots of good speakers are confirmed! Lisa talked about sponsors/vendors and stated that more are needed. Would like to see vendors from throughout the state. Having more vendors/sponsors would also help lower the cost of the conference. Hoping to keep fees at around \$100 for seniors and a little more for professionals. Motel cost is \$94 per night. Lisa also stated that donations of door prizes and bag stuffers are needed. Also asking for each Triad group to donate a basket for a silent auction. Discussion regarding having each Triad group bring a display board highlighting their group's activities. They are setting up a link for registration, so you can register and pay online. The hotel is already taking reservations. Several donation options were discussed – Lions, Legions, Chambers, Salvation Army, Target, Walmart.

Kandiyohi County is scheduled to host the 2020 Conference on October 6-7, 2020 at the Convention Center in Willmar.
