Training Announcement

The Anoka County Sheriff's Office is hosting a Jail/Corrections Use of Force Instructor Course

October 19 - 23, 2020

This is a train-the-trainer course specifically designed for a jail or correctional setting. The student trainer will learn how to teach mental, verbal, and physical skills directly related to a correctional setting.

The course will include all aspects of standing and ground control, escorts and come-alongs, hobble leg restraint, take-downs of violent prisoners, submission holds and basic self-defense. Blunt and sharp trauma defense (knives, pipes, improvised weapons), searching cooperative and violent prisoners, wheel chair searching, cell and dayroom extractions, and rear seat squad car extraction tactics will also be taught.

The course is instructed by MSA's Use of Force instructor Steve Anderson. Steve was the Use of Force Instructor for the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office prior to his retirement. He implemented the use of force unit in Hennepin County in 1995. His complete biography may be accessed on the MSA web site under Steve Anderson trainings.

This is a 40 hour course and is POST accredited. The cost for this course through the Minnesota Sheriffs' Association is only \$625.
