Licensed Use of Force Instructor Training

October 5 - 9, 2020

The course is instructed by MSA's Use of Force Instructor Steve Anderson. Steve was the Use of Force Instructor for the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office prior to his retirement. Course Description

This is a train the trainer course that will instruct the perspective student trainer how to teach all POST Board mandated physical use of force training, including mental and verbal skills, arrest tactics, handcuffing of all types, escorts, vertical and ground control, takedowns and maximum holds for violent handcuffing, pepper spray techniques, and flashlight blocking techniques. It also includes low light arrests, a total baton program including maximum holds, standing and officer knocked down weapon retention for handgun and long gun, hobble leg restraint application, and Taser handcuffing. The course is specifically designed for reality and simplicity regarding all items that the officers carry on their duty belt.

Attendees must be a licensed peace officer to attend this school. It is specifically designed to teach the prospective use of force trainer how to teach all POST Board mandated licensed skills. This is a 40 hour course, POST approved credits.
