He has attended Gavin de Becker and Associates' Advanced Threat Assessment and Management Academy in Lake Arrowhead, California and is also a member of the Association of Threat Assessment Professionals--specializing in the assessment and management of targeted violence. Randy has received advanced training in workplace violence prevention, stalking, domestic homicide prevention, school violence and terrorism. He has also completed the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Law Enforcement Training Center's Domestic Violence Instructor course and was a national instructor with the National Center for Victims of Crime's Stalking Resource Center out of Washington, D.C.
