<b>E * (class specific)</b>	<b>Not valid for CMV's with a manual transmission</b>
<b>H</b>	<b>Automatic Transmission Class D</b>
<b>K</b>	<b>Intrastate only (CMV's only)</b>
<b>L</b>	<b>Driving only vehicles without airbrakes</b>
<b>M</b>	<b>Not valid for class A passenger bus</b>
<b>N</b>	<b>Not valid for buses over 26,000 GVWR</b>
<b>O</b>	<b>Not valid for tractor/semi-trailer</b>
<b>V</b>	<b>Medical waiver by FMCSA</b>
<b>W</b>	<b>Not valid for passenger capacity of 24 or more</b>
<b>Z</b>	<b>Not valid for CMV's with full air brakes</b>

The E restriction is class-specific, so a driver with a class A CDL must use the highest type of class A CMV with a manual transmission to remove the restriction.

**For example, if a driver is eligible to drive a class A, tractor semi-trailer combination, the driver must bring a tractor semi-trailer with a manual transmission to remove the E restriction.**

M – All drivers testing in a school bus or passenger bus will receive this restriction.
