The Department of Pathology at the University of Michigan Health System in Ann Arbor, Michigan is seeking an MD or MD, PhD Forensic Pathologist.

The primary responsibilities will be associated with providing forensic pathology services at the Wayne County Medical Examiner's Office under the direction of Carl J. Schmidt, MD, Chief Medical Examiner, in collaboration with Jeffrey M. Jentzen, MD, PhD, Professor and Director of Autopsy and Forensic Services at the University of Michigan Health System. It is anticipated that this will account for 85% of effort, with the remaining effort (15%) spent in the teaching of students, residents, and fellows' other academic pursuits. Excellent diagnostic skills and board certification in Anatomic Pathology and Forensic Pathology are required within two calendar years of hire. The successful candidate will be a fully credentialed member of the Department of Pathology at the University of Michigan, a department comprising over 180 faculty with extramural research support totaling over \$32 million dollars.

Alexandra Le Tellier wrote in the LA Times in October 2013 that Detroit, home of the Wayne County Medical Examiner's Office, is a city of, "*Opportunity. Optimism. Engagement...the ingredients of the great American comeback story.*" Quicken's billionaire owner, Dan Gilbert, moved his headquarters into the heart of the city and has spent more than a billion dollars on property acquisitions.
